Fu Xiaotong is known for her intricate paper pinhole creations of "traditional" landscape compositions. She currently teaches at the School of Arts at North China University of Technology and resides in Beijing and Germany.

Kelly Wang's work explores the tension between dimensions as well as hard, defined edges and soft, organic forms. Wang's unconventional, pioneering techniques push the boundaries of what "ink art" can be.
